1. Please can you get a fan in the waiting room

We have considered this, however, it is a shared waiting room and it would involve risk assessments and cleaning schedules to ensure it didn't post a safety and infection control risk. We appreciate the waiting room can become warm and stuffy, however, the hot temperatures are normally limited to a small number of weeks each year. Therefore, we believe the increased infection control risks outweigh the potential benefits. NHS Property Services (the owner of the building) are aware the skylights don't work; we believe this is on a "job list" so will, hopefully, be restored before next summer and mean windows can be opened to let air in.
